Terre Forti Sangiovese Rubicone, Italy

Delicious, easy-going Italian red made from the same grape used in Chianti – black cherries, plums and peppery spice make it an ideal match for Mediterranean dishes.

La Serre Merlot Vin de Pays d'Oc, France

Young, juicy and full of soft, easy-going plum and blackberry fruit. A real taste of the South of France.

Les Nuages Pinot Noir St Pourcain VDQS, France

A light, delicate red from the Loire Valley – crunchy redcurrant and strawberry fruit flavours make it a great red wine to match with fish, especially salmon or trout.

Fleurie Millesime Cave de Fleurie, France

A perfect summertime wine – soft and juicy with loads of red berry fruit and very light tannins.

Morgon Marcel Lapierre, France

Widely regarded as the best wine in Beaujolais, this great wine tastes more like an expensive Burgundy than your average Morgon. Subtle, elegant and fresh with delicious cherry and strawberry fruit. Very sophisticated stuff.
